New Patient Dining Room Services Coming to Hurley

“At Your Request Room Service Dining” by Sodexo is coming to Hurley this month. This will provide patients with customized meal choices, available when they would like to dine. The service will be available from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm (7 days a week). The “restaurant style” menu includes a wide variety of foods including made to order omelets, deli bar, pizza and grill favorites in addition to entrees, salads, vegetables and desserts.

There will be a special menu for Pediatric patients. All items will be available for all meals. The Menus will also be available in Spanish and Arabic. When patients are admitted, Nursing assesses whether the patient can pick up the phone to call in their food orders or if they will need assistance. Patients are categorized in EPIC as “Appropriate for Room Service”, “Appropriate with Assist” or “Not Appropriate”. All patients needing assistance will be visited by a Nutrition Services employee to help them place an order.

Nutrition Services will also keep track of which patients have called at each meal. If they don’t hear from the patient, they will call them for an order. EPIC EMR interfaces with the Nutrition Services Health touch from EPIC. Health touch system will screen diet selections so only foods that match the patient’s diet order will be served. Allergy information is also indicated, along with preference.

This information will be stored for future visits. Patients will call 27200 from in the hospital or 810.262.7200 from outside of the hospital. Food will be delivered within 45 minutes of that call. Family members can order meals for patients from any location such as home or office. Up to three meals can be ordered at a time.
