Dr. Seif Saeed was born in Omdurman, Sudan to a family abundant in both numbers and determination. He is the fourteenth child out of a remarkable eighteen, with ten brothers and seven sisters. Dr. Saeed was first inspired to pursue medicine by his older brother, Dr. Elmahdi Saeed, and sister, Sumia, whom are both physicians. As his career progressed, his brother became particularly instrumental in his personal and professional development. However, the most fundamental source of motivation behind Dr. Saeed's success is undoubtedly

his mother, Aziza. Aziza was never afforded the opportunity of basic literacy, so she was avid – and triumphant – in instilling a high value of education in her children. It was with the same devotion that she continued to raise nine children after their father's death in 1970. Aziza was referred to as a saint in their neighborhood, as nobody could fathom how she managed to provide and persevere for her large family. As a result of their mother's influential passion and strength, all siblings have gone on to be successful. Dr. Saeed's history set the stage for his dynamic and compassionate presence in the medical field.

Dr. Saeed attended the University of Khartoum – Faculty of Medicine in Sudan graduating in 1982 with a MBBS. He completed additional training at the Omdurman Teaching Hospital, serving as a House Officer until 1983. In 1986, Dr. Saeed completed training at Kadugly General Hospital located in Southwest Province, Sudan. He received his Part I Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons (FRCS) in Edinburgh, Scotland in 1988.

In 1989, Dr. Saeed came to the United States to visit his brother. During his visit, he met Ms. Goode, who was the administrative assistant for the Program Director at Hurley Medical Center Pediatrics, Dr. Gordon. She and his brother, Dr. Elmahdi Saeed, convinced him to consider coming to Hurley. As he considered this opportunity, Dr. Saeed returned to Saudi Arabia to take his Foreign Medical Graduates Examination in the Medical Sciences (ECFMG). He spent two years working in King Fahad Specialists Hospital. He was then offered an interview with Dr. Gordon and his assistant, Dr. Susumu Inoue. After the interview, Dr. Inoue offered Dr. Saeed a position in Pediatrics.

Later, he was offered a position in Internal Medicine/Pediatrics by Dr. Hamp. He then completed his residency (Combined Medicine/Pediatrics) in 1994. "Hurley became more of a family to me. It has provided me with so many opportunities to include; where I received my training opportunity, my first job with Hurley Health Services, teaching, and it is the place where my children were born. I want to give back to Hurley what has been given to me. I have created long lasting friendships that continue to shape my life."

Upon completion of the residency program in 1994, Dr. Saeed accepted a position with Hurley Health Services at their Court Street location with Dr. Carravallah. Dr. Saeed continued his studies and completed his fellowship program in Academic Medicine at Michigan State University in 1997. Soon he moved to the South Saginaw Internal Medicine office which was also owned by Hurley Health Services. He held this position until 1999. At that time, he joined the medical practice of Dr. Fleetwood and Dr. Khalid Ahmed.

In 2001, Dr. Saeed became a partner with Dr. Khalid Ahmed at Michigan Health Specialists, a primary care group with offices in five locations and with more than ten providers. In addition to being a clinical setting to treat patients, the offices also serve as robust training grounds for educating area students of all levels – high school students, medical students, PA's, NP's, residents and more. Their office in Grand Blanc, now houses an Urgent Care Facility owned by Hurley Health Services. In 2005, Dr. Saeed completed his studies and obtained his Executive Healthcare MBA from Oakland University in Rochester, Michigan.

Dr. Saeed is Board Certified in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics. He is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians. He currently serves on the Internal Medicine Advisory Committee. He is an active member with the Genesee County Medical Society, Michigan State Medical Society, American Medical Association, and the American College of Physicians, Community Health Committee, and American Academy of Pediatrics.

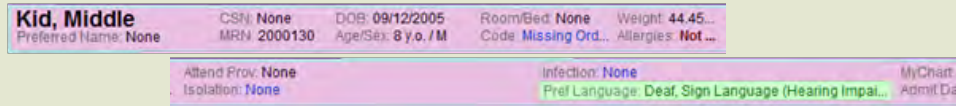
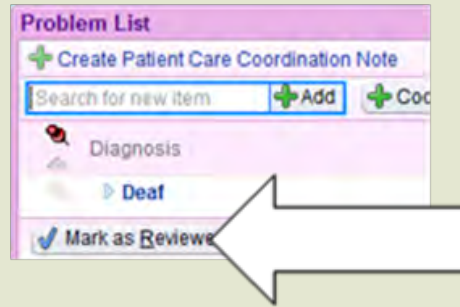

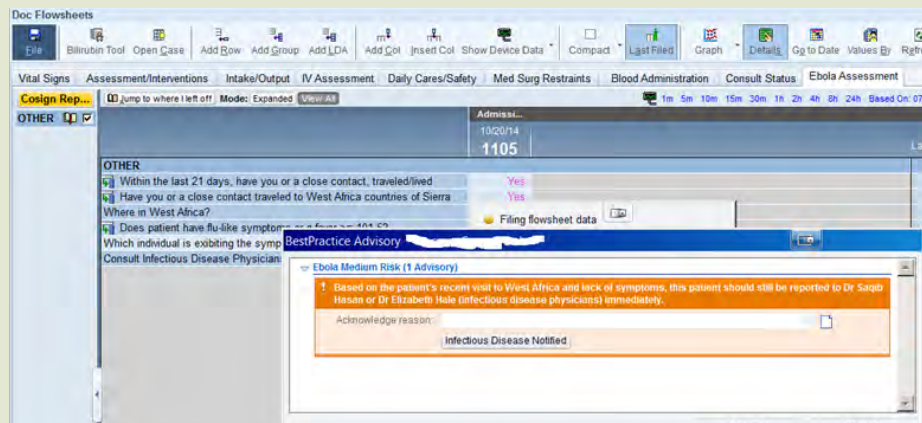


Travel History Screening for Ebola

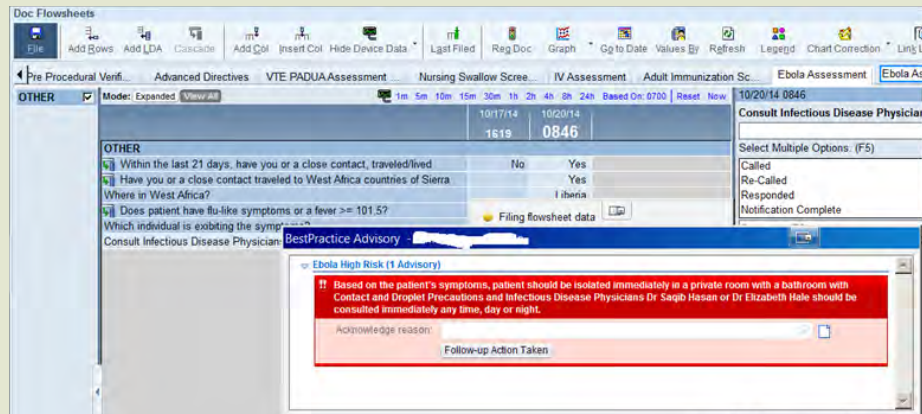
All points of patient origination (ED, OB Triage, Direct Admit, Same Day Surgery, etc.) should now be screening for potential exposure to the Ebola virus. Admitting & the Nursing Office are responsible for Direct Admits.

Below see examples of two BPAs which direct screeners as to how to react to positive answers to screening questions. All individuals have access to the flowsheet below if they would like to review the documentation. Search flowsheets by using the word "Ebola" and then click the Facility list tab.

***Orange BPA – indicates a travel history (WITHOUT symptoms)



***Red BPA – includes the presence of symptoms in the patient
